Downtown Surge Classroom – Design Thinking

The display for this space is a projector and manual screen.

Controlling the system with your Device

- 1. Connect to the project via HDMI cord Turn the projector on using the NEC remote (normally located on the instructor's station)
- 2. Connect the Avaya Camera Locate the USB cable connection and connect it to your device.

MacBook: If your computer does not have the appropriate USB port you will need to use an adapter. Connecting the USB web camera into a hub or docking station will not work.



3. Select Avaya HC020 as the camera and microphone source

In your chosen video conferencing interface (Zoom, WebEx, or Teams) select Avaya HC020 as the camera and microphone source.

Note: The Avaya remote can be used to adjust the camera (left, right, zoom in, zoom out). If the camera does not respond to input from the remote

- Make sure the camera is on by looking for the blue light (this tiny light will be located beside the camera's lens)
- Press the "1" button on the remote
- Try the input again
- Note that if the camera has reached its max zoom, it may not respond because no additional adjustments can be made

Microphone not working?

- 1. Ensure the sound system is on On the back left the "On/Off" button should be depressed
- 2. Ensure the microphone cable is connected to Mic 1 If necessary turn the level control up
