In-room cameras are only available via the instructor station.

CameraOneLINK Bridge

Microphone SHURE P300

This camera has a remote.

Cameras are not actively recording or streaming unless in use by the instructor station.

Using the In-Room Technology

- Turn the system on.

 Using the Crestron Touch control panel, touch the screen to turn the system on. This will also turn on the projector.
- Turn on and log into the Instructor Station computer.
 In-room cameras are only available via the instructor station.
- Open Zoom, WebEx, Teams, or other needed software programs.
- Select OneLINK Bridge as the camera and SHURE P300 as the microphone source. In your chosen video conferencing platform (Zoom, WebEx, or Teams) select OneLINK Bridge as the camera and SHURE P300 as the microphone source. The remote can be used to adjust the camera (left, right, zoom in, zoom out).

Troubleshooting the Camera

If the camera is not available, it may be turned off.

Turn the camera on by pressing the power button on the remote.

If the camera is not responding to the remote, then press the "1" button on the remote.

If the camera is zoomed all the way out, it may not respond to the direction controls.

Speaker systemTo use the in-room speakers choose either "Crestron" or "Same as System" as the speaker.
